


Transition into Phase: Students transition into Phase 5 from Phase 4, following the pathway which best suits their individual needs. Students are grouped according to age, ability stage and appropriate peer group. The students in Phase 5 form a predominantly KS 3 / Ks 4 cohort. Moving on from KS 2 / KS 3, students continue to build upon prior knowledge and learning whilst being introduced to a curriculum with an increased focus on preparation for adulthood.



Transition out of Phase: Students transition from Phase 5 into Phase 6. Phase 6, based off-site, follows on from Phase 5 pathways and aims, incorporating plans and expectations to ensure students are equipped for the next stage of their independence/ education. Phase 5 continues to prepare learners with social confidence and an enquiry-based mindset ready for life post Cleaswell.
